- ✓ CHEM 111.002 General Chemistry Lab (CRN #60144) 1 credit hour Tuesdays 1:20-4:20 pm with Professor Majeed
- ✓ FYS 178.003 First Year Seminar: Science and Practice of Learning and Thriving in College (CRN# 60519) – 3 credit hours Tuesdays & Thursdays 9:55 am -11:10 am with Professor Wasileski
- MATH 167 Pre Calculus or MATH 191 Calculus I based on placement, enroll in any section that fits your schedule – 4 credit hours
- ✓ Any other 3-4 credit hour course of your choosing, such as an elective in an area of interest to you LANG 120 Academic Writing and Critical Inquiry or HUM 124 Ancient World
